OUR GOD NEVER CHANGES

In this life, we are constantly bombarded with change. Everything around us seems to be in a constant state of change! The Bible teaches that God does not change or mutate. The Bible pictures God as a Rock. "Because I will publish the name of the LORD: ascribe ye greatness unto our God. He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he" (Deuteronomy 32:3-4).

God's nature is unchangeable. God is the same yesterday, today, and forever. "Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever" (Hebrews 13:8). James states the immutability of God in this way, "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning" (James 1:17). Notice that God's unchangeableness is so certain that He has no shadow from turning. God's nature and being are infinite. Therefore, God has no beginning and no ending. He, and He alone, is eternal. There has never been a time when God did not exist. All that God is today, He has always been. "For I am the LORD, I change not..." (Malachi 3:6).

God's counsel is also immutable. "The LORD bringeth the counsel of the heathen to naught: he maketh the devices of the people of none effect. The counsel of the LORD standeth for ever, the thoughts of his heart to all generations" (Psalm 33:10-11). Men frequently change their mind and their actions. God is all powerful (omnipotent) and all knowing (omniscient). Since God knows all future events, His mind cannot be changed for lack of anticipation. Since God is all powerful, He can accomplish whatever He desires.. He is immutable. His counsel, therefore, must be immutable as well (Hebrews 6:13-20).

God's immutability should be a source of comfort and encouragement for the child of God. Since God has promised those who love Him and obey His Word will be eternally blessed; we should be comforted and encouraged. "Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him" (Hebrews 5:8-9).
