JESUS HEALS A LEPER (Matthew 8:1-4, Mark 1:40-45, and Luke 5:12-16)

INTRODUCTION:

1. This event takes place shortly after Jesus began His earthly ministry. This is not His first miracle. It is recorded in John 2 where Jesus turned water into wine.

2. Jesus had just finished the greatest sermon ever recorded, the Great Sermon on the Mount.

- 3. The recording of this miracle is short, but powerful.
- 4. We could rightly call it the "Touch of the Master's Hand"!

5. A word about leprosy. This was a dreaded disease in the First Century. It was basically a death sentence. A horrible death sentence. Death came both slowly and cruelly. It is a disease of the skin. The Jews often considered leprosy as a punishment from the hand of God.

6. This left the one with leprosy without help or hope!

DISCUSSION:

- 1. THIS LEPER APPROACHED JESUS IN HUMILITY.
 - 1. Notice the leper came and worshiped Jesus and said, "Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean" (verse 2).
 - 2. Humility is essential in salvation. Many are the passages which detail God's abhorrence of the proud spirit (Proverbs 6:17).

2. THE MASTER'S TOUCH.

- 1. Jesus was moved with compassion (Mark 1:41) and healed the man immediately.
- 2. What a great act of compassion! Touching a man who was unlawful to touch (Leviticus 13:45). Obviously, God was instituting the practice of confining people who were contagious.
- 3. Jesus is the Perfect High Priest (Hebrews 4:14-16).

LESSONS LEARNED:

- 1. Jesus is compassionate when we sin (Hebrews 5:1-10).
- 2. We must approach Jesus in humility (James 4:10).
- 3. Be thankful (Luke 17:11-19).
