JESUS WALKS ON WATER (Matthew 14:22-33)

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Mark 6:45-52.
- 2. John 6:15-21.
- 3. As we have mentioned before, by reading all the accounts of the account of Jesus walking on water gives us a deeper understanding of this miraculous event.

DISCUSSION:

- 1. THE CROWDS WANTED TO FORCE JESUS TO BE KING.
 - 1. John 6:15.
 - 2. Jesus understood that the time was not right (John 7:6).

2. JESUS SENDS THE DISCIPLES AWAY BY SHIP.

- 1. Jesus wanted to spend time alone to pray. He went up on a mountain to pray (Matthew 14:23).
- 2. While Jesus was on the mountain a great (Greek word is "mega") storm arose and the disciples struggled to get the ship to the shore. They had rowed for about 3-4 miles with the wind fighting against them.
- 3. While fighting against the wind, they saw Jesus walking on the water and were afraid thinking they were seeing a spirit (Matthew 14:49). The word spirit refers to a "phantom" in the Greek.
- 4. Jesus intended to pass by but seeing their distress, He calls out to them "Be of good cheer: it is I; be not afraid" (Mark 6:48-50).
- This was not the first time Jesus calmed the sea (Mark 4:35-41).
- 6. Even after calming the sea earlier and feeding the 5,000 the disciples still did not understand Who Jesus is (Mark 6:52).

3. PETER ALSO WALKS ON THE WATER.

- It is interesting that Peter asks Jesus for permission (Matthew 14:28). At least, Peter had the courage to leave the ship.
- 2. It seems Peter took his eyes off Jesus and looked at the wind and immediately he cried out and Jesus saved him (Matthew 14:28-33).
