THE GOLDEN RULE (Matthew 7:12 and Luke 6:31)

It was a cold, windy day, January 24, 1848. James Marshall was struggling to cut a channel out of the rock of the South Fork of the American River. It is said that in his frustration, he put in a bigger charge than usual of dynamite. When the smoke, dust, and water cleared; James Marshall uttered these now famous words, "Boys, I think we found gold."

The city of Placerville, CA now stands close to the ghost town of Coloma. It was called Dry Diggin's before it was called Placerville. It would be called "Hangtown" for many years because of a numerous hangings which took place there. The sleepy port town of San Francisco, at first became a ghost town with its population heading for the mountains to find gold, grew from 1,000 to 25,000. It is estimated that 200,000 people came to California looking for gold.

There are usually four rules of life practiced by mankind. Each of these "rules" can be seen in the Parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37).

- 1. IRON RULE: might makes right (Thieves in the story of the Good Samaritan).
 - 2. BRASS RULE: take care of number one (Priest and Levi).
- 3. SILVER RULE: stated this way by Confucius (551 BC), "Do nothing unto others, you would not have them do to you." This rule is good, but it does not encourage me to actually help my fellow man.
- 4. GOLDEN RULE: treat your fellow man the way you desire him to treat you.

WHAT IF WE PRACTICED THE GOLDEN RULE?
