EVERY MAN UNDER HIS FIG TREE

INTRODUCTION:

1. Zechariah 2:1-3:10
2. We are continuing our study of the fascinating book of Zechariah.
3. We discussed last week that Zechariah functioned as a priest as well as a prophet.
4. Zechariah is second only to Isaiah in prophecies concerning the Messiah.
5. Chapter Two contains a beautiful plea for Israel to return to her land.
6. Chapter Three has one of the most poignant pictures of Israel dwelling peacefully, every man under his fig tree!
7. Zechariah has eight visions. In Chapter Two we see the vision of the man with a measuring line (tape measure). In the third chapter, Zechariah saw a confrontation between Jehovah and satan. Joshua is anointed high priest.

DISCUSSION:

1. **Zechariah Chapter Two**
 1. God measures Jerusalem (vs. 1-5)
 2. God promises restoration and redemption (vs. 6-9)
 3. God promises He will return and dwell in Jerusalem (vs. 10-13)
2. **Zechariah Chapter Three**
 1. Joshua, the high priest, is cleansed (vs. 1-5).
 2. God promises to restore the covenant with Israel (vs. 6-7).
 3. The Branch and the Corner Stone promised (vs. 8-10).
