The Day of the Small things

INTRODUCTION:

1. Zechariah 4:1-5:11
2. We are continuing our study of the fascinating book of Zechariah.
3. Last week we saw Joshua anointed as high priest (3:1-7). Zerubbabel is appointed governor by the Persians, but also anointed by God (Zech. 4:6).
4. Zechariah sees another night vision in Chapter Four. He sees a golden candlestick attached by pipes to two olive trees.
5. In Chapter Five Zechariah sees a flying scroll. He also sees a woman in a basket returned to Shinar (Babylon).

DISCUSSION:

1. Zechariah Chapter Four

1. Zechariah sees a golden candlestick attached to two olive trees (vs. 1-10).
2. He is told that Zerubbabel would rebuild the temple from a mountain of rubble, but he would do it by the blessing of God and not by his own might (vs. 6-10).
3. The Angel explains that God's anointed were Zerubbabel as governor and Joshua as high priest (Vs. 11-14).

2. Zechariah Chapter Five

1. Zechariah next sees a flying scroll (representing the Law of Moses returning to its rightful place among God's people (vs. 1-4). This is the restored covenant talked about in Chapter 3:6-7.
2. Zechariah also sees the scroll applying to everyone, perhaps pointing to the coming of the New Covenant (v. 4).
3. The next vision is a woman sitting in a basket. The angel informs Zechariah that this represents wickedness: probably idolatry. (vs. 5-7).
4. The woman (idolatry) is returned to Shinar (Babylon). This signifies that God will not tolerate idolatry in Israel (vs. 8-11)
