THE BOOK OF JONAH

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Solomon correctly stated that there is nothing new under the sun.
- 2. In our lesson this morning, we are going to look at the life of the prophet Jonah.
- 3. We are immediately struck with the fact that Jonah is not like most prophets of God. When God called Isaiah, he said, "Here am I; send me" (Isa. 6:8). When God called Jonah, he ran.
- 4. It is sad, but true that most of us are more likely to react like Jonah.

DISCUSSION:

1. RUNNING FROM GOD (PROUD).

- 1. Nineveh is approximately 500 miles northeast of Jerusalem.
- 2. Tarshish is about 2500 miles west of Palestine.
- 3. The idea is clear; with God you can run, but you cannot hide.

2. RUNNING TO GOD (PENITENT).

- 1. Sometimes we must find ourselves at the bottom of the ocean before we become penitent!
- 2. Jonah recognized the futility of running from God (Luke 15:17).

3. RUNNING WITH GOD (POWERFUL).

- 1. Our power comes from God (Phil. 4:13).
- 2. Only when we acknowledge God, and His power can we truly become powerful!
- Nineveh a great city. It was 60 miles in circumference. It was surrounded by a wall that was said to allow three chariots ride abreast. The wall was said to have 1500 watch towers 200 hundred feet tall!
- 4. The city hears the message of God! This brought repentance from the greatest to the smallest. Oh, how we long for honest hearts to hear God's message today!

4. RUNNING AHEAD OF GOD (POUTING).

- 1. Sadly, many times we find ourselves in this position. We are not immune to the desire to run ahead of God. How many times do we seek to "change" God's word so that it will suit ourselves?
- 2. Again, we see the pride of Jonah, he did not want to "look bad" in the sight of the people (verse 2).
