#### The Man Whose Name is The Branch

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

- 1. Zechariah 6:1-7:14
- We saw Joshua anointed as high priest (3:1-7). Zerubbabel is appointed governor by the Persians, but also anointed by God (Zech. 4:6). Zechariah sees a golden candlestick attached by pipes to two olive trees (Chapter Four). In Chapter Five Zechariah sees a flying scroll. He also sees a woman in a basket returned to Shinar (Babylon).
- 3. As we enter Chapter Six, we see the final vision Zechariah is given. It is four chariots.
- 4. Chapter Seven begins with emissaries asking a question concerning fasting.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

#### 1. Zechariah Chapter Six.

- 1. Zechariah has a vision of four chariots coming out from two mountains of brass. The horses are colored red, black, white and grisled or spotted.
- 2. The prophet asks the meaning of these and the reply in verse 5 is that this are four winds (spirits) sent to patrol the earth.
- 3. Beginning in verse nine, we see Jesus crowned as King, Prophet, and Priest (High Priest).

### 2. Zechariah Chapter Seven.

- 1. We see in Chapter Seven that Zechariah's visions are ended and now he begins one of his two "sermons."
- 2. First he asked a question about fasting. The children of Israel had been commanded to fast on one day of the year (Lev. 23:27). During their captivity, the Jews had started fasting in memory of the destruction of Jerusalem in the fifth month (2 Kings 25:8). The question, should we continue this fast now that we have been restored to the land?
- 3. The response from God is quite shocking, He says you were not fasting for Me or eating for Me; you were doing it for yourself.
- 4. The sermon that is preached concerns the need for pure religion tempered with justice, mercy, and compassion.
