The King Betrayed

Zechariah 11:10-14

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Zechariah 10:1-11:17
- 2. We are continuing to look at Zechariah's first burden. In chapter nine, we learned that God would defend Israel, send them a humble King (Jesus), and that God would ultimately save the nations through this King.
- 3. In Zechariah chapter ten, Zechariah will warn the nation to look to God and not to idols, and He promises that them that He will save and restore them.
- 4. We learn in chapter eleven that ultimately God foretells the destruction of Jerusalem. Why? Because they would betray the King God sends them.

DISCUSSION:

- 1. Ask Jehovah, not idols (10:1-2).
 - 1. The children of Israel are told to ask God and not idols.
 - 2. Idols are not the answer!
- 2. God Will Bless Israel (10:3-12).
 - 1. Just as God had punished them for sin, He will bless them for righteousness.
 - 2. He will strengthen them if they continue in His will.

3. Israel Will Be Destroyed (11:1-3).

- 1. This section of scripture perfectly illustrates that God's blessings can be withheld if men turn away from Him.
- 2. The voice of howling will be heard for the pride of Jordan will be destroyed.

4. The King Betrayed (11:4-14).

- 1. Now Zechariah informs them of the reason of their destruction in AD 70.
- 2. God knew they would reject His Messiah for the price of a servant gored by an ox (Ex. 21:32). What an insult to our loving God!
- 3. Because of this outrage, God would take away His favor (Beauty) and break the Bands of His protection.
- 5. Israel Turned Over to a Worthless Shepherd (11:15-17).
 - 1. God tells Zechariah to announce that Israel would be given to a foolish shepherd.
 - 2. He would have all the characteristics of a worthless shepherd. He would not care or provide for the flock.
 - 3. He would ultimately be humiliated as well.
