The Owens-Rogers Museum Tour: \$8 pp

Groups may tour this 1906 Craftsman Bungalow where screenwriter Lela Rogers lived and academy award winning actress, singer, and dancer Ginger Rogers was born in 1911. See the room where Ginger was born, and many of the original features that were in the house at the time. View unique items and gowns that were owned by Ginger Rogers, including the dress she wore to the academy awards in 1967.

View Ginger's family history, original movie posters and magazines, news articles, books, and photos during Ginger's visits in 1942, 1964 and 1994. See milk bottles and photos from Ginger's Rogue River Ranch in Oregon and her hat from the ranch. Many items in the museum were donated by adoring fans across the U.S. Period antiques were obtained by the owners to create an authentic atmosphere. Visit the gift counter with postcards, books, milk bottles, and prints by Ginger Rogers, and dolls by Linda Lee Sutton.
