Newport Council Budget

We have been horrified by the Newport Labour Party council tax increase of 8.5% and the 3 weekly bin collections. We led the charge and fought long and hard to make a proposed amendment which scrapped the move to 3 weekly and reduced the council tax increase to something more palatable. We fully costed an alternative and proposed to use some council reserves to help residents this year given the tough times we face. Unfortunately we were voted down as Labour has a significant majority of councillors. We will keep trying to ensure that services are not cut.

We have managed to secure an agreement that the 3 weekly bin collection will only apply to houses and not communal flats as this is where the bulk of the issues remain. This will alleviate some foreseeable problems.
