AARP tax aide will be here at the JSC Wednesdays beginning February 1, through April 12, 2023 to prepare Federal and State Income Tax's. You will need to make an appointment by calling the center at 401-944-3343. You also will need to bring your last years filed tax papers with you along with your ID and all documents from 2022 income.

February is the time to file the <u>Property Tax 1040H Forms (TAX Relief)</u>. This is for people who <u>DO NOT</u> file federal Income Tax. You may qualify if your household income is \$30,000 or less. When you receive your SSA 1099 form.(2022 Awards Letter) give Madeline a call to assist you at

If anyone still needs assistance with applications for Heating Assistance (monthly income below \$2689 single or \$3516 couple), or Medicaid, Snap, Housing or any other programs give us a call. We will be happy to assist you and answer any questions you may have.
