From the Cookbook of Jackie Rave "Ricotta Cheesecake"

Step 1:

In a mixer, mix 1 lb of ricotta cheese, 1 lb of cream cheese, 4 eggs, 1 ½ cup of sugar, 6 heaping tbsp of flour, 2c of milk, 2 tsp of vanilla extract, 2 tsp of lemon extract. Once mixed, cook at 300 degrees for 1 hour and 20 minutes.

Step 2: Preheat the oven to 400 degrees, this mixture will go on top of the cheesecake. Mix 2c of sour cream and 8 tbsp of sugar. Once mixed, bake for 10 minutes.

Step 3: Make the Graham Cracker Crust to your liking or follow directions on the back of the box and let set overnight in the refrigerator.

Step 4: Use a 10in Springform Pan to assemble the cheesecake and let it set in the refrigerator overnight.
