## Baptismal Registration Form – Godparents:

The Holy Roman Catholic Church requires the following of Godparents: (canon 874.1)

- The godparents (one male/one female) are to be chosen by the parents or guardians.
- They are to be <u>at least sixteen years of age, Confirmed, and leading a life in harmony</u> <u>with the Faith</u>, ie: practicing Catholics who attend Mass every single week, are in a valid Marriage (if applicable), and follow the moral teaching of Jesus. They may not be the father or mother of the one to be baptized.
- A letter of good standing, from their Pastor, is needed for all godparents.
- They will promise to encourage and help you in raising your child in the Catholic Faith.
- \*\*Non-Catholic Witness (Can.874.2):
  - A **<u>Baptized</u>** person belonging to a non-Catholic ecclesial (church) community may be admitted as a witness to baptism but *only along with Catholic Godparents*. This person is not formally a Godparent, but a Christian Witness. This *practice is greatly discouraged* because the Godparents promise God to help raise your child in the practice of the Catholic Faith. It will require the Pastor's signature and proof of their *valid* Baptism.

# **Baptismal Checklist:**

- Attend a Baptism Preparation Class, please discuss this with the Parish Priest.
- Complete the Baptism Request Form and return it to the Parish Priest.
- Along with the Request Form submit copies of the following:
  - IF you are NOT an active member of St. Mary's, St. Thomas of Canterbury, or All Saints: A letter of good standing and a letter of permission to receive Baptism outside your Parish Territory from your Pastor. This is required by Canon Law.
  - ALL BAPTISMS: Obtain letters of good standing from the Pastor of the Godparents. This is required by Canon Law.
- Go to Confession asap.
