Baptismal Registration Form - Godparents:

The Holy Roman Catholic Church requires the following of Godparents: (canon 874.1)

- The godparents are to be chosen by the parents or guardians.
- They are to be at least sixteen years of age and **Confirmed**. They should be leading a life in harmony with the Faith, ie: practicing Catholics who attend Mass, are in a valid Marriage (if applicable), and follow the moral teaching of Jesus. They may not be the father or mother of the one to be baptized.
- **Non-Catholic Witness (Can.874.2):

Proposed Godnarents

- A <u>Baptized</u> person belonging to a non-Catholic ecclesial (church) community may be admitted as a witness to baptism but *only* along with a Catholic Godparent. This person is not formally called a Godparent, but will be referred to as a Christian Witness.
- This practice is discouraged because the Godparents should be helping to raise your child in the practice of the Faith.
