Elementary Clubhouse Enrichment Programs

(Monday-Friday: 3:15pm/3:30pm-5:00pm/5:15pm, Grades 1st-4th)

Our afterschool programming is curated from nationally recognized, standards-aligned programs such as 4-H, Project Learning Tree, and Jr Great Books. We have created lessons to help your child become a global citizen, steward of our Earth, strong leader, and a confident learner. Throughout the week LGCS offers interdisciplinary activities that integrate with science, language arts, social studies, reading, math, art, music, and civics. Groups will be broken up developmentally 1st-2nd Grade & 3rd-4th Grade. While LGCS has never wanted to be a "daycare", we welcome the opportunity to offer enrichment programs for those families looking for something more to enhance their child's day or while their parents are working.

We know there's a lot of great learning happening, but your child is just going to think they are having another fun day on the farm.

Mondays- The Adventures of the Traveling Journal: Children are given the opportunity to grow as a global citizen as they explore other cultures through age-appropriate activities. Each week children will write in their "passport" journal about the adventures they have listening to stories, creating art projects, learning dances and "traveling" the world. Expressive language skills of story-telling and writing will be stressed.





<u>Tuesdays- STEM Day:</u> Children will complete activities that help them explore ideas of chemistry, engineering, physics, and math. STEM programs use hands-on activities to teach problem solving, creative and critical thinking, and inspire kids to explore science and technology. If your child loves to make crazy chemistry concoctions and build structures

they will love Tuesdays on the farm.

<u>Wednesdays- LGCS Green Keepers:</u> Children learn to be stewards of our environment and local community as they explore and complete activities in our farm setting. We will learn about animal and farm life as well as the nature setting surrounding us through stories, hikes, songs, and activities. If your child loves to see the bunnies and enjoys our nature trails, they are sure to enjoy becoming a LGCS Green Keeper.





Thursdays- Creative Arts: Children grow as they express themselves through art, movement, and language. Children will get to explore different mediums as they create free art projects as well as crafts.

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eLearning Hybrid Programs (Monday-Friday: 8am/8:15am-3pm)

Many families do not want their children on an iPad all day or are working and not able to supervise eLearning all day. They are torn between pulling their students completely from the district for private schooling or leaving their child on an iPad all day long. LGCS has worked hard to come up with a compromise for families. Children will login to the class for all synchronous programs. Students will participate in lessons created by LGCS teachers for "specials" such as art, PE, music, science and social studies during asynchronous blocks of times. Children will be outside as much as possible participating in our Outdoor Education curriculum enjoying the opportunity to learn from nature and the farm. The best part is that children are constantly exposed to academic concepts without feeling like they are doing school "work".

Homeschooling Program (Monday and Tuesdays: 1pm-2:30pm)





 A 10% discount is given for each sibling. There is a 5% discount for any tuition paid in full by August 15th or upon registration through the semester for new students. Any discounted payments and prepayments are non-refundable This includes monthly, semesterly, or annual tuition payments. Any discounted payments and 	 Insufficient Funds Fee: There will be a \$25 service fee for all checks returned for insufficient funds. There is no refund for Tuition Payments for any reason including vacation, sick days, pandemic/national disasters or moving. Regular tuition is due for weeks with holidays. Tuition may be prorated to the end of the current

semester of attendance if a family moves or if a

child withdraws from enrollment.

Payments Plans:

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Annual Payment Plans: Payment is due by August 15th.

prepayments are non-refundable.

- Monthly Payment Plans: The monthly payment plan is due on the 15th day of the month prior month. For example, September Tuition is due on August 15th.
- Semester Payment Plans: The first payment is due on or before August 15. The second payment is due by January 15.

Release and Waiver of Claims

In consideration of my child's enrollment in Long Grove Country School and/or Long Grove Country School Summer Camp, we agree to release and hold harmless and indemnify Long Grove Country School and/or Long Grove Country Camp, its agents and employees, from and against all damages, liabilities, losses and expenses (including attorney's fees) arising out of or resulting from any claims, causes of action or demands whatsoever, made by us or by any other person or entity on the behalf of the child's participation in Long Grove Country School and/or Camp to the extent permitted by law, except for acts of omissions involving willful or wanton conduct by a director, officer, employee or agent of Long Grove Country School and/or Camp, and we hereby waive any and all such claims, demands and causes of action.

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited the congregation of groups of people.

Long Grove Country School (LGCS) has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, the LGCS cannot guarantee that you or your child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19. I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to my child(ren) or myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that I or my child(ren) may experience or incur in connection with mychild(ren)'s attendance at the LGCS or participation in LGCS programming ("Claims"). On my behalf, and on behalf of my children, I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless the Long Grove Country School, its employees, agents, and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of the Long Grove Country School, its employees, agents, and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in any LGCS program.

Each child must have a guardian sign the parent handbook acknowledgement page confirming that they have read and agree to Long Grove Country School's policies and procedures. This includes policies and procedures for safety regarding Covid-19.

Photograph Release

We permit Long Grove Country School and/or Camp to use photographs, films, videotapes and other facsimiles of the child taken during and/or camp (and related activities) in its brochures, newspapers, slide presentations and any other publications concerning promoting Long Grove Country School and/or Camp.

Classes/Group Assignment

Long Grove Country School reserves the right to assign students to a specific classroom if this is in the best interest of the child or consolidate classes if attendance is low due to illness, enrollment or other factors to encourage socialization and/or individual development.

Vaccines & Immunization

Long Grove Country School requires all students to provide the state required immunizations, vision, and hearing examining required by the State of Illinois for their child. This form should be available at your Pediatrician or doctor's office and must be submitted before your child may start school or summer camp.

<u>Birth Certificate</u>: State licensing requires a certified copy of the enrolled child's birth certificate to be copied by the school before attending school.
