
Rainbow Necklace

What you need:

Index Cards Yarn Tape Cereal Loops in Rainbow Colors Portion Cups Markers





What you do:



Prepare one necklace strand per child by knotting a cereal loop at one end of a piece of yarn and taping the other end for easy stringing. Make a set of pattern cards with colored dots for children to use as guides for stringing cereal loops in a rainbow pattern.



Make a set of six sorting cups for each child by writing color words on portion cups. Review each color word and the order the colors appear in a rainbow.



Give each child a pile of cereal loops in all six colors to sort into the cups.



Show children how to string their sorted cereal loops in a repeated rainbow pattern to make their necklaces.
