

Florence "Pancho" Lowe Barnes was a California heiress & celebrated pioneer aviatrix who founded the first movie stunt pilots' union & was Lockheed Aircraft's first female test pilot. She was also the founder of the notorious "Happy Bottom Riding Club", now on the site of Edward's Air Force Base.


Pancho outflew Amelia Earhart, outsmarted Howard Hughes, outdrank the Mexican army, and outmaneuvered the U.S. government. Her favorite quote was "When you have a choice, choose happy."
