While our reserve account remains healthy, this will delay other non-emergency projects.

I want to thank those of you who supported the Board's proposed budget at the last Annual Meeting and resisted the urge to lower our 2015 condominium fees. That action would have compromised

our ability to respond during this past winter's emergency situations.

We have scheduled some roof repairs and other minor building repairs in the next few months. We are moving forward with replacing the fence along Route 11B and will be reporting to you when we have bids and options.

We are also pursuing the possibility of bringing a property management team onto our property to aid us in both property maintenance and financial reporting. The workload of our volunteer Board continues to grow, and we hope to put in place a plan of action to keep our community a wonderful place to live for many more years.

I urge you to go out and enjoy the warm weather, cool water, and many events happening around the lakes region. Have a wonderful summer!

This expense was not part of our original budget for 2015. With the arrival of warm weather, we plan to address the important issues needing immediate repairs. As always, our buildings will take precedence for these repairs.

For the unit owners who pay by "electronic check" from your bank, please allow 7 to 10 business days for your check to reach Sundown. Plan ahead when using this form of payment. Just a reminder, all condominium fees are due on the first of every month. Thank you to all for continuing to pay your condominium fees on or before the required due date.
