As a practising, clinical member of ANZACATA, I agree to abide by the Standards of Professional Practice and Code of Ethics of the Australian, New Zealand and Asian Creative Arts Therapy Association Ltd and by the Codes of Ethics required in my jurisdiction of practice.

With my professional practice all clients and participants can be assured that I will:

- Provide services in a safe and ethical manner
- Obtain consent
- Display appropriate conduct in relation to advice provided
- Report concerns about the conduct of other health care workers
- Take appropriate action in response to adverse events
- Adopt standard precautions for infection control
- Take appropriate and timely measures to minimise harm to others if they are diagnosed with infectious medical conditions
- Not make claims to cure certain serious illnesses
- Not misinform clients or participants
- Not practise under the influence of alcohol or unlawful substances
- Not provide treatment or care to clients while suffering from a physical or mental impairment, disability, condition or disorder that places or is likely to place clients at risk
- Not financially exploit clients or participants
- Not engage in sexual misconduct
- Comply with relevant privacy laws
- Keep appropriate records
- Be covered by appropriate insurance; and
