

BRUSH MANAGEMENT PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- 1. Cost-share is limited to \$5,000.00 per landowner per year.
- 2. Cost-share will be fifty percent (50%) of the bills submitted for payment by Carlsbad Soil and Water Conservation (SWCD). Bills are to include chemical costs, equipment rental, labor costs, or application costs by licensed applicators, fuel costs, etc.
- 3. The Natural Resource Conservation Service standards and specifications for brush management and prescribed fire will be followed when applying practices.
- 4. Herbicide application rates will follow the recommendations on the manufacturer's label. The total amount of herbicide will not exceed allowable rates.
- 5. Cooperator (landowner) will sign a waiver releasing Carlsbad SWCD from any liability connected with his/her application of brush management practices.
- 6. Cost-share will not be allowed on a practice being cost-shared by another agency, group or individual.
- 7. Pictures of proposed project site must be submitted with Brush Management Program application.

VEGETATION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM HERBICIDE USE GUIDELINES WAIVER

The following guidelines must be followed for use of herbicide as part of the Carlsbad SWCD Vegetation Management Program:

- ALL HERBICIDE LABEL DIRECTIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED Read the label on the herbicide provided and follow all label recommendations and instructions.
- WEAR PROPER PERSONAL PROTECTION EQUIPMENT (PPE) WHEN APPLYING HERBICIDE Read the label on the herbicide to determine the level of PPE that must be worn while using the chemical provided.
- USE THE HERBICIDE PROVIDED ONLY ON THE TARGETED SPECIES LISTED ON THE VEGETATION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM FORMS The herbicide provided for your project has been selected for the plants that you requested to treat. Do not treat other types of plants without first consulting with District Staff to approve/disapprove the use of the chemical outside the scope of your project.
- FOLLOW RECOMMENDATIONS FOR CHEMICAL APPLICATION ON PROVIDED NMSU FACT SHEET
- DO NOT APPLY CHEMICAL WHEN THE FOLLOWNG CONDITIONS ARE PRESENT:
 - o Temperature is above 90 degrees Fahrenheit
 - o Wind speed is above 7 miles per hour
 - o Rain is in the immediate forecast (within the following 12 hours after application)
