ELIGIBILITY & INFORMATION

Please keep the first page of this package for reference. The remainder of the pages must be returned along with other information required by the deadline stated.

The Texas Junior Brangus Breeder Association awards three scholarships each year to outstanding high school seniors. To be eligible to apply for one of these scholarship awards, a candidate must meet the following criteria:

1. Applicant must be a member of the TJBBA
2. Applicant must be an active TJBBA member in both the show ring and junior activities for at least two (2) years prior to the current show year.
3. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior.
4. Application must be received by May 11th with high school transcript, SAT and (or) ACT scores (if applicable).
5. The recipient of this scholarship may pursue any course of higher education or trade school.
6. To retain the scholarship, the recipient must complete at least one semester at a college, university or institute. If the course of the semester is not completed, scholarship monies must be refunded to the scholarship chairperson. The scholarship funds will be paid to the school of the recipient's choice, as required, when the recipient submits evidence of enrollment.
7. Application must be hand written or typed. All applicants will be judged by an appointed committee.
8. Application must include your current high school transcript, SAT and/or ACT score(s) (if applicable), Head Shot, and three additional pictures of your choosing with a brief caption or description.

DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS

Funds for the scholarship awards will be directly sent to the college or university that the recipient will attend. It is imperative that recipients notify TJBBA Advisor, Shelbie Van Beveren, by email at least 30 days before scholarship funds must be received by the recipients' chosen college or university. Providing false information to TJBBA is grounds for forfeiture of the scholarship. All scholarship proceeds must be used by each scholarship recipient within five (5) years after his/her graduation; any funds not used at that time will be forfeited, unless an extension to use said funds is granted by TJBBA.
