## VISION


A world in which repairing, healing, and thriving are accessible to everyone.

To provide trauma-informed programs, coaching, and classes for people who have been impacted by interpersonal trauma to create the conditions for healing and wholeness.



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## **Expanding access to quality trauma-informed support services to create the conditions for healing and wholeness.**

In 2025 thanks to the support of capacity building and program grants we have had the opportunity to expand our programming to offer more comprehensive services to the population we serve.

In addition to our REPAIR program and internship programs, we have designed

curriculum for a new program, THRIVE, that will launch in 2026, and expanded individual support services through Medi-Cal partnerships to provide enhanced care management to clients with complex needs.
