RULES & CLASSIFICATION CATEGORY:

Current CMP pistol competition rules will govern in their respective matches. The CMP Competitor Classification system will be used for all matches. Classification and TSRA membership will be checked before or at time of registration.

Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class unless there are three (3) or more unclassified competitors. In that case, a special unclassified class will be provided. 2026 CMP Bullseye Competition Pistol Rules: <https://share.google/jinT4mjxrMsGyxbmK>

EQUIPMENT & SIGHTS:

Pistols or revolvers being used must comply with the CMP Rules that apply to the match being fired. See Empty Chamber Indicators (ECIs), eye and ear protection are required on or near the firing line.

ELIGIBILITY FOR EVENTS: All competitors must be members of the TSRA. Non-Members who are not a resident of Texas must become a match member for a fee of \$10.00. A match member is a member of TSRA for the duration of the match. All Texas competitors are required to be members in good standing of the TSRA.

ENTRY FEES: TSRA Outdoor Precision Pistol Championship (Match Pistol 2700): Adults \$80, Juniors \$40; TSRA Outdoor Service Pistol Championship: Adults \$30, Juniors \$15; CMP EIC (.22, Revolver and Pistol) and .22 Rimfire Championship Matches: \$20 each – Payment can be taken in person during registration or you can visit: <https://txbullseye.org/ols/all>
