



Call for Application Fellowship of FAPA College of Pharmacy (FACP) Thailand Chapter

The FAPA College of Pharmacy (FAPA CP) Thailand Chapter invites applications from distinguished pharmacists for the **Fellowship of FAPA College of Pharmacy (FACP)**. This prestigious fellowship recognizes pharmacists with exceptional qualifications and a strong commitment to advancing pharmacy practice.

1. Eligibility Criteria and pathways

Applicants must choose one of the following pathways based on your eligible criteria:

Pathway A – Equivalent Training Completed

- Licensed pharmacists who have completed training from the Equivalent Training Programs accredited by FAPA CP.

Pathway B – No Equivalent Training

- Licensed pharmacists with at least 10 years of experience and who have not completed the Equivalent Training Programs.

Additional Criteria (All Applicants):

- Certificate is endorsed by their respective training program or supervisor of their organization.
- No record of engagement in illegal or unethical practices

2. Application guideline

Pathway A –Equivalent Training Program

Required Documents (PDF format):

- **Comprehensive Curriculum Vitae (CV)** must include:
 - Personal information (name and contact details)
 - Education and Training (including pharmacy degree and relevant qualifications/certifications)
 - Professional Experience (chronological, with key responsibilities and dates)
- **English-language Publication** : upload one publication that reflects your area of expertise.
- **Residency / Fellowship Training Certificate** : documentation confirming completion of the Equivalent Training Program.
- **Payment Slip for Application Fee** : proof of transfer of THB 8,500 to the account below.

- **Evaluation process** is based on submitted documents

Pathway B – No Equivalent Training

These applicants must complete the 5-Step Fellowship Process.

Step 1 – Prepare All Required Documents

- ☐ **Comprehensive Curriculum Vitae (CV)** must include:
 - Personal information: name, contact details
 - Education and Training: specify your pharmacy degree and other relevant qualifications or certifications
 - Professional Experience: chronological list of positions held with key responsibilities and dates
- ☐ **Executive Summary of Professional Contribution** ([see guidelines below](#))
- ☐ **Payment Slip for Application Fee** : proof of transfer of THB 8,500 to the account below.

Step 2 – Complete the Online Application Form

- Upload all prepared documents including payment slip in PDF format with your application.
- All applications must be submitted by **December 25, 2025**.

Step 3 – Complete the Coursera Course “Introduction to Digital Health”

- The Coursera account will be assigned to you. You will have 2 months to complete the course.
- Register LinkedIn account (<https://www.linkedin.com/>) and enroll as a member of the FAPA CP network. (<https://www.linkedin.com/groups/14717445/>) For those who already have LinkedIn account, just enroll as member of the FAPA CP network.
- Post your certificate of completion on your LinkedIn account.

Step 4 – Written Examination

- **Date: February 7, 2026.**
- Format: Closed-book essay exam (3 hours, in Thai or English).
- Content: Analyze challenges in your practice area and propose ideas for improvement.

Step 5 – Presentation & Interview (via Zoom)

- **Date: To be announced**
- Format:
 - **10-minute presentation (in English):** Present your Professional Contribution as outlined in your Executive Summary.
 - **20-minute interview:** Panel explores your professional contributions, motivation, vision for advanced training, and commitment to supporting FAPA CP Indonesia Chapter.



3. Guideline for Preparing Executive Summary of Professional Contribution

Applicants must prepare and submit one Executive Summary describing their most significant professional contribution. This single project will be used for both your written submission and your oral presentation.

Your Executive Summary should clearly demonstrate your specialization and expertise. The outline below is provided as a guide. You may include additional elements that best showcase your professional contribution.

- **Title of Your Project or Contribution**
 - A clear, concise title reflecting your specialized area.
- **Area of Specialization**
 - State your field of practice or expertise (e.g., clinical pharmacy, pharmacovigilance, supply chain management).
 - Explain how it aligns with your professional focus.
- **Introduction / Background**
 - Briefly describe the context or problem you addressed.
 - Indicate the objectives and relevance to your practice and / or specialized field.
- **Methods / Conceptual Framework or Tools Used**
 - Explain the approach, model, or tools you used to carry out the work.
- **Description of the Work and Your Role**
 - Clearly outline what you did, your responsibilities, and leadership role.
 - If the work was team-based, specify your **personal contribution**.
- **Outcomes and Impact**
 - Highlight measurable results, improvements, or innovations achieved.
 - Describe the effect on patients, systems, or the profession.
- **Benefits and Potential for Scale-Up**
 - Indicate how this contribution can be expanded, adapted, or used as a model for others.
- **Supporting Documentation or Data (if available)**
 - Include figures, charts, references, or external recognition that support your contribution.

Examples of Acceptable Project Types

Your professional contribution may include (but is not limited to):

- Publication in a recognized professional or academic journal.
- Presentation at a major conference.
- Significant contribution, innovation, or initiative reflecting your expertise.
- Other publicly recognized work that advances pharmacy practice.

Tip: Choose one strong project that best represents your specialization and leadership. It will form the basis of both your Executive Summary and your Presentation during the interview.
