## **Application Deadline:**

## **Qualifications:**

- Licensed pharmacists with a minimum of 15 years of experience in a specialized field OR
  - licensed pharmacists who have completed residency training in a specific field from a recognized institution in the US or UK.
- Endorsement by their respective Pharmaceutical Association or IAI.
- No record of engagement in illegal or unethical practices.

## **Documentation Required:**

- Completed application form.
- Comprehensive Curriculum Vitae (CV) highlighting professional achievements and contributions.
- For those with formal residency training, a copy of the residency training certificate must be submitted.

### **Evaluation Process:**

- Candidates will undergo an evaluation process that includes a 10-15 minute presentation in English to the Court of Examiners via Zoom on August 24, 2024. The presentation time for each qualified candiates will be announced and a Zoom link to attend the session will be sent to each candidate.
- During the presentation, candidates must articulate the following points:
  - o **Contributions or achievements in their specialized field**: Highlight significant accomplishments and notable projects.
  - o **Motivation to join the FAPA CP Founder Fellowship**: Explain what drives them to be a part of this program and how they envision it benefiting their career and the pharmacy profession.
  - **Vision for advanced training in their specialized field:** Describe plans to develop training programs that will enhance professional competencies and elevate standards of practice.
  - o **Commitment or contribution planned for FAPA CP Indonesia**: Discuss how they will support the advanced training, including any initiatives or projects they aim to undertake.

#### **Expectations of Founder Fellowship Recipients:**

- Successful candidates will be recognized as Founder Fellow of the FAPA CP Indonesia chapter (Indonesian Founder FACP).
- To be eligible for Indonesian Founder FACP, successful candidates must attend the FAPA CP session on November 1, 2024 at the FAPA Congress 2024 in Korea.
- Responsibilities of Indonesian Founder FACP include:
