DAY 01, LOS ANGELES -LIMA

Depart Los Angeles international airport to Lima, Peru.

DAY 02, ARRIVING IN LIM

Upon arrival, our local guide will wait for you then transfer to your hotel. In the afternoon enjoy a visit to CONTEMPORARY LIMA: Discover Lima's most traditional residential areas: El Olivar in San Isidro, Miraflores, and Larcomar. Continue to Barranco beach for lunch at a local restaurant. Return to the hotel. Optional excursion: Dinner at Dama Juana with a folk dance show. Overnight dinner.

DAY 03, LIMA CITY TOUR

This morning's tour of Lima, with its 2000 years of history, begins at the colonial center of the city, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site, with its historic buildings surrounding the splendid Plaza Mayor. View the impressive Palace of the Archbishop with its fine carved balcony, the opulent Government Palace, official residence of the President, and the 16th century Cathedral of Lima whose first stone was laid by Pizarro. Continue to the 17th century Monasterio de San Francisco complex with its magnificent tiles. Visit the

DAY 04, LIMA TO CUZCO

Depart Lima this morning by flight to Cuzco, in the Peruvian Andes. This ancient capital of the Inca Empire is the oldest continuously inhabited city in the western hemisphere, designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Upon arrival, depart for a tour of Cuzco. View the impressive Colonial Cathedral, which contains over 400 paintings from the Cusqueña School in addition to colonial art. Continue on to visit the Koricancha, the Temple of the Sun, once the most important religious site of the Incas, whose walls and floors were allegedly once covered by sheets of solid gold. Transfer to your hotel in the Sacred Valley.

DAY 05, CUZCO - MACHU PICHU

Early morning transfer to the Sacred Valley's Ollanta Station to board the train that travels through misty peaks to the astonishing ancient citadel of Machu Picchu*, the "Lost City of the Incas", designated by UNESCO as one of the New Seven Wonders of the World. Machu Picchu was virtually unknown to the western world until Hiram Bingham's rediscovery in 1911. Spend the morning viewing the unforgettable wonders of this 15th century retreat, abandoned nearly 100 years later with the arrival of the conquistadors. See the highlights of the site including the imposing Temple of the Sun, the House of the Priest, and the Sacred Plaza. Return to the Sacred Valley in the early evening and transfer to your hotel in Cuzco for overnight

DAY 06, CUZCO CITY TOUR

Spend today at leisure in the "Imperial City" of Cuzco. Take time to explore some of the city's stunning sights or shop for some of the finest handicrafts and textiles in all of Peru. Perhaps, participate in the *optional* Cuzco Behind the Scenes Tour, offering a glimpse into the other side of life in Cuzco. On this tour, visit a local market and taste fresh-baked Chuta bread. Stop at the Cuzco cemetery to learn more about Andean life and death and meet with a local "shaman" (holy man). After the cooking demonstration, enjoy a delicious meal. In the afternoon, attend the *optional* tour Half Day Ancient Cuzco Ruins which explores some of Cuzco's most unique Inca Ruins. Tonight, savor a 3-course set dinner, featuring delectable Andean specialties

DAY 7, CUZCO-BRAZIL (D)

Breakfast at the hotel when the time allows transfer to the airport to board a flight to São Paulo, Brazil. Upon arrival at the airport, your guide will be waiting to transfer you to the hotel.

DAY 08, SAO PAULO-RIO DE JANEIRO

Breakfast at the hotel then transfer to Rio with one stop in the Cathedral Basilica of our Lady of Aparecida. On the afternoon transfer to Rio de Janeiro. Overnight and dinner

DAY 09, RIO DE JANEIRO (B, D)

Buffet breakfast at the hotel, 'This morning visit the Corcovado Mountain, one of the most spectacular views of the city, and home to the famous statue of Christ the Redeemer. Your next stop is Sugarloaf Mountain, a picturesque tourist landmark of Rio de Janeiro.

DAY 10, RIO DE JANEIRO (B, D)

This morning, enjoy breakfast at the hotel followed by an all-day city highlights tour. During this 8-hour excursion, you will visit the four most important cultural and natural icons of Rio. Your itinerary starts with Tijuca Forest, the largest urban forest in the world, featuring spectacular exotic Brazilian flora, waterfalls, and trails
