Rules:

- 1. No running with a gun and all firearm safety rules needs to be followed.
- 2. All hunters are required to wear a blaze orange vest or hat.
- 3. 12-gauge and 20-gauge ammo will be available if needed as well as a single shot 20-gauge shotgun for those that don't have a gun.
- 4. All GUNS must be unloaded until mentor provides 1 shell at a time to the youth hunter once dog is on point and steady. Back up gunners will not shoulder guns until a bird is in the air. Guns should be carried muzzle up in the field.
- 5. All dogs should be healed and on lead to and from the field. E collars and GPS collars are ALLOWED. We strongly recommend carrying water for your dog.
- 6. Everyone must check in and be present for safety meeting the morning of the event. Safety meeting will begin at 8am sharp. It is strongly encouraged that you arrive prior to the start of the safety meeting!
- 7. Hunter must be at the field prior to the completion of the run prior to keep the event running smoothly. A field marshal will be there to help prepare hunters.
- 8. All birds must be shot in the air.
- 9. If your dog is in heat, you will be asked to hunt last.
- 10. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES during the event!
- 11. All runs will be 30 minutes max time and 4 total bird contacts, bagged, missed or flushed.
