Winter Honeybee Facts

- Honeybees keep the inside temperature of their winter cluster at 95 degrees.
- Wind-driven cold is the most harmful factor that results in bee deaths in cold climates.
- A bee will not die until its body temperature reaches 41 degrees or lower.
- Winter bees have a completely different make-up than summer bees and can live up to 6 months!
- The only time a bee leaves the hive in the winter is when the temperature climbs to 55 or higher for a cleansing flight (in other words, to go to the bathroom).

Recipe of the Month



Sweet Honey Mulled Wine

Recipe by Chef Charles Heaton

Instructions:

- Combine ingredients in an appropriate sized saucepan.
- Heat to approximately 150F to 160F, stirring occasionally to dissolve the honey.
- Allow to steep and serve with desired garnishes.

Garnish suggestions:

- Orange slices
- Cranberries
- Raisins
- Apple slices

Ingredients:

- 750ml Bottle of full-bodied red wine
- 3/4 cup Honey
- 3/4 cup Water
- 1 Fresh Cinnamon stick (or two)
- 3 Whole Cloves
- 3 Strips of Orange Zest
- Other potential spices: cardamom pods, star anise, black peppercorns, allspice berries
