

Purpose: This Scholarship is intended to help families provide school supplies and clothing for their school-aged children. The Suffering Package is a scholarship opportunity of helping those who are suffering in this world with circumstances that are out of their control. Our ministry wants to help you in a way that brings peace and justice to your life.

Amount Awarded: Scholarships will be awarded from \$125-500 based on need and church connection.

Criteria: The families eligible for the Suffering Package Scholarship must be families with at least one school-age child that attend one of the following churches:

- Grace Independent Baptist Church at 679 Long Ln, Upper Darby, PA 19082
- North Chester Baptist Church at 2331 Providence Ave, Chester, PA 19013
- Bethel Baptist Church at 2210 E Susquehanna Ave Philadelphia PA 19125

If you attend a church that is connected with **Youth Action Ministries, please contact DrTonyRizzoPhD@youthactionministries.com for approval**

Consideration will be given to the families connected to approved churches and are recommended by a Pastor from those churches. Families must submit a picture of the family, an address, a short essay explaining their reason for financial aid for their school-age children, and proof of involvement at the previously approved churches.

Guidelines: Scholarships will be awarded through the pastors after proof of attendance and connection with the churches. Families must continue to attend and stay connected with their church. Scholarship money must be used to assist in the needs of the children, such as providing school supplies and clothing.

Selection Process: A Selection Committee of the Director of Youth Action Ministries and the Pastors of the previously mentioned churches will assess the applications and essay portion in the application form.

Renewal Process: This scholarship is renewable from the original application after one year times. Only families with children attending the previously mentioned churches or Youth Safety Zones may apply.
