Brands Mentioned & What We Know

Canadian-Made Dog Foods

- 1. Carna4 (Ontario)
 - High-quality, minimally processed kibble alternative
 - o Uses sprouted seeds for natural vitamins and minerals
 - No synthetic additives, fillers, or preservatives
 - o Known for helping dogs with skin and digestive issues
- 2. Hurraw (Canada)
 - o Dehydrated dog food
 - o High-quality ingredients, but not much mainstream info available
- 3. **TLC Pet Food** (Ontario)
 - Home delivery service (big convenience factor!)
 - o Balanced formulas for all life stages
 - Manufactured in Canada but ingredient sourcing unclear
- 4. **4 Strong Paws** (New Hamburg, ON)
 - o Local Ontario raw pet food brand
 - o Limited public information, but known within raw feeding circles
- 5. **Open Farm** (Toronto, ON)
 - Canadian company with ethically sourced ingredients
 - Offers kibble, freeze-dried, and raw-mix options
 - High focus on sustainability and transparency
- 6. Inukshuk (New Brunswick)
 - o High-performance kibble for working and active dogs
 - o Marine 25 formula is nutrient-dense and great for hard keepers
 - Popular among sled dogs, working breeds, and athletes

Very concentrated formula allows for smaller feeding portions

7. Raw Performance (Niagara, ON)

- o High-quality raw dog food made from local, human-grade proteins
- Well-respected in the raw feeding community

8. Congo Raw (Ontario)

- o Family-run business focused on premium raw diets
- Uses human-grade, locally sourced ingredients
- No fillers, preservatives, or synthetic additives

9. Iron Will Raw (Ontario)

- Well-known in the raw feeding community
- o CFIA inspected (Canadian Food Inspection Agency)
- o Uses hormone- and antibiotic-free meats

10. Muskoka Raw (Muskoka/Barrie, ON)

- Serves the Muskoka area with raw food options
- o Offers pre-portioned meals for convenience

Canadian-Owned but Made in the U.S.

- 11. **Performatrin Ultra** (Sold at Pet Valu, Canadian-owned)
- Made in the U.S. but Pet Valu is a Canadian company
- Lamb & rice formula known for improving coat health
- Loyalty program (free bag after every 12)

12. Purina

- Canadian-owned but manufactured in the U.S.
- Some concerns over ingredient sourcing and transparency

General Insights from the Discussion

- "Made in Canada" vs. "Sourced in Canada" Some brands manufacture in Canada but source ingredients from the U.S., which isn't always disclosed on labels; consider reaching out to brands directly to ask about their supply chain.
- Raw vs. Kibble Debate Many engaged pet owners opt for raw or home-cooked meals, supplementing with highquality kibble like Carna4 or Inukshuk.
- Home Delivery Options Are Popular TLC Pet Food and some raw brands (like Muskoka Raw) offer home delivery, which adds value for busy pet owners.
