Events this term

Assemblies - We are delighted to be able to have assemblies in person again this term. We realise that this will be the first time our younger pupils (and some of our older new additions!)

have experienced this and that being together in a large group for the first time can be a bit daunting. For the first few weeks we will split assemblies into lower and upper wing and gradually move towards a whole school gathering before inviting parents/carers to also join us. We will let you know when parents/carers are invited to attend.



Leavers' Assemblies will take place for nursery on Wednesday 29th June and for school on Thursday 30th June both at 11am. Parents/carers will be able to attend as long as restrictions do not change in the meantime.

Open event - We are excited to welcome parents/carers back into the school building and look forward to our first open event since 2019! Parents/carers are invited to come in to school/nursery on Friday May 20^{th} to share learnings and view Learning Profiles. We will confirm the timings nearer the time.

We would also like to invite parents of children in P1 and P2 (or of older children who have joined school in the last two years) the opportunity to have a tour of the school to see our learning environment. If you would like to join please meet in the foyer outside the office on Friday 6^{th} May at 1pm.

Photographs - The photographer will return to school on Wednesday 11th May to take

photographs of family groups. Children who are in nursery will be included with their siblings in school. If you would prefer a photo of a different group (e.g cousins) or to include younger siblings still at home, please get in touch. The photographer will also take individual photographs of children in P5/6 who were isolating during her previous visit.

Sports Day - Sports Day for nursery will take place on Wednesday 12^{th} May or 19^{th} May if the weather is unsuitable at 9:15. Sports Day for school will take place on Wednesday 25^{th} May or 1^{st} June at 1:30 depending on weather. These events will take place on the pitch. Parents/carers are invited to attend both events.



Queen's Jubilee - We are currently planning an event to celebrate the Queen's Jubilee in June. We will give you more information soon. A reminder that school and nursery are closed on Friday 3rd June in celebration of this event.

Transition - A priority for this term will be ensuring a smooth transition for all children to their new classes in August, especially our new nursery and P1 children and our P7 children moving up to secondary school. Move up days for our P7 children going to Kingussie High School will be Tuesday-Thursday 21st-



23rd June. Our new nursery children will be invited in for visits on Tuesday and Wednesday 21st and 22nd June and all the other classes in the school will experience two move up mornings in their new classrooms with their new teachers on these dates as well. Nursery and P7 children will take part in further transition activities this term such as the 'Resilient Kids' programme to learn more about embracing changes positively and informal visits to the school and playground during nursery sessions.
