Week beginning 25th April 2022-

Article 38-Protection in War (Link to Ukraine War)

Article 38: Children have the right to be protected during war. No child under 15 can join the army or take part in war.

Week beginning 9th May 2022-

Article 30-Minority culture, language and religion

Children have the right to use their own language, culture and religion-even if these are not shared by most people in the country they live.

Week beginning 23rd May 2022 -

Article 7-Name and nationality

Children must be registered when they are born and given a name which is officially recognized by the government. Children must belong to a country.

Week beginning 6th June 2022-

Article 10- Contact with parents across countries

If a child lives in a different country than their parents, governments must let the parents and child travel so that they can stay in contact and be together.

(Set 2020-Staying in contact with your family)

Week beginning 20th June 2022-

Article 33-Protection from harmful drugs

Governments must protect children from taking, making, carrying or selling harmful drugs.
