The Rights of the Fortnight and Global Goals for Term 3 (2022) are:

Week beginning 10th January 2022-

Article 14 (freedom of thought belief and religion)

Every child has the right to think and believe what they choose and also to practise their religion, as long as they are not stopping other people from enjoying their rights. Governments must respect the rights and responsibilities of parents to guide their child as they grow up.

(Link to World Religion Day which is celebrated every year on the third Sunday in January.)

Week beginning 24th January 2022-

Article 42 - Everyone must know children's rights

Governments must actively work to make sure children and adults know about the Convention.

SDG 4: Quality Education

Week beginning 7th February 2022 -

Article 16 - The Right to Privacy

Every child has the right to privacy. The law should protect the child's private, family and home life, including protecting children from unlawful attacks that harm their reputation.

Week beginning 28th February 2022-

Article 2 (non-discrimination)

The Convention applies to every child without discrimination, whatever their ethnicity, **gender**, religion, language, abilities or any other status, whatever they think or say, whatever their family background

Week beginning 14th March 2022-

Article 12 (respect for the views of every child)

Every child has the right to express their views, feelings and wishes in all matters affecting them, and to have their views considered and taken seriously
