



Rationale:

We believe that school uniform plays a valuable role by encouraging identity with, and support for, our school ethos; ensuring equality and promoting good relationships. For these reasons, we also believe that school uniform supports effective teaching and learning.

Children are expected to wear the following school uniform:

- Purple sweatshirt or cardigan.
- Plain white or purple shirt, polo shirt or t-shirt (with or without school logo)
- Plain trousers, skirt, shorts, joggers or leggings dark colours such as grey and black
- Purple gingham dress or Black/Grey Pinafore Dress
- Grey School fleece (optional)
- School tie (optional)
- Children are discouraged from wearing jewellery and smart watches are only permitted if on 'school mode.'
- Children should not wear make-up including nail extensions/false nails.
- Children should bring a pair of indoor shoes to school that can be worn inside and for P.E lessons. These should be left in school. Children should wear appropriate outside shoes to travel to and from school. Snow boots/wellingtons are encouraged for winter weather. Parents/carers should provide velcro or zip fastening shoes until children can tie their own laces.

Children must wear shoes in the school building at all times. If shoes are being removed for P.E they should be stored in a way that will enable children to access them in case of a fire alarm!

<u>P.E. Kit</u>

- Shorts, leggings or track suit bottoms
- Plain purple or white t-shirt (with or without school name/logo)
- Gym shoes (must be well fitted)
- Bobble (for children with long hair)
- Plasters or medical tape (to cover earrings that cannot be removed)

Children are <u>not</u> permitted to wear football strips and must remove <u>all</u> jewellery before participating in any physical activities.

Any alternative uniform arrangements should be discussed with the Headteacher.

Lost Property

It is essential to ensure that all personal items brought to school are **clearly labelled with your child's name and class** so that lost items can be returned.

Un-named items will be collected and placed in a box, which is located at the end of the corridor in each shared area.

Items which remain uncollected will be displayed on the last day of each school term. Items which continue to remain uncollected will be disposed of.
