Prepare your mind and body for the academy. As mentioned, this is a very demanding academy both physically and mentally, which you will be expected to participate. Academy days are 12 hours or more.

Tuition Fee

This is a program of The American Legion, Department of Arizona. Unfortunately, these programs come with a cost. The staff are all volunteers that give their time to make this a successful and rewarding experience for youth that wish to pursue a career in Law Enforcement or Military.

The cost associated with this program come from the facilities rental fee that provides lodging, 3 meals a day, uniform supplies, and program necessities such as hydration, medical and first aid supplies, equipment & classroom training supplies, and liability insurance.

The average cost per applicant is estimated at \$650. To help us make this possible we ask for a tuition fee of \$300.00 per applicant, which is non-refundable. If a financial hardship exists, the applicant's application will be held until a sponsor can be secured for it. Applicant will be notified if there are any problems connected with their application.
