### 1890s to 1900s Global Women's Suffrage

1890

- The National American Woman Suffrage Association was formed with Susan B. Anthony, Lucy Stone, and Elizabeth Cady Stanton as the officers.
- In the United States, Wyoming becomes first state to grant women the right to vote.

1892

- Susan B. Anthony is elected president of the National American Woman Suffrage Association.

1893

- New Zealand grants women right to vote.
- Cook Islands universal suffrage, (British protectorate.)

1894

- South Australia granted women the right to vote and run for office.

1895

- First woman in the world ran for office in South Australia.

1898

- Danish Women's Society's Suffrage Union founded in Copenhagen, Denmark.

1902

- Australia grants women right to vote.

1906

- Finland grants women right to vote.

1907

- World's first female member of parliament voted into office in Finland.
