4 Term Breakdown

Term 1 - Improvisational Skills

- ❖ Basic understanding of improvisation and mime

Term 2 → Story Telling - The Art of Listening and Telling a Story (Skills from Play Back Theatre)

Term 3 → Script Work

Establishing, developing and performing a script.
