## 4 Term Breakdown

### Term 1 - The Magic of Inspiration

- ❖ We will start the year with a variety of activities, tasks and projects to develop skills that can be used to draw on for inspiration in creating and developing performance concepts.

### Term 2 → Collaboration & Improvisation

- ❖ Building on the performance creation concepts learnt in term one, we will work on learning, developing and practising the guiding principles of improvisation, making strong offers, building improv communication skills and bringing flavour to a performance through feeling and emotion.

### Term 3 → Devising & Creating

- ❖ Using a selected theme, students will improvise a variety of scenes relating to this theme and decide what aspects they like and what didn't work, before taking the selected ideas, developing the concepts and creating a loose script to follow for an end of year performance.

### Term 4 → Creating Trust & Sharing the Magic

- ❖ Using the performance concept established in Term 3 students will build and develop their end of year performance. We will explore how to maintain the structure of a performance and trust/support of your fellow performers, whilst also bringing variety, flavour and flexibility to the stage.
