



Storytelling Beginner 2020

To build and develop basic storytelling and character-building skills through the use of our bodies, voices and movements. For the first half of the year, we will do so by exploring a story and the different characters in it, and then creating a performance for our mid-year showcase. In the second half of the year, we will explore a different story or script to perform at our end-of-year showcase, developing and improving skills learnt over the first part of the year. We aim to become comfortable performing and creating ideas and developing our knowledge of drama.

Term Breakdown

Terms 1 & 2 → 'The Witches'

During these terms we will explore *The Witches* by Roald Dahl. We will explore the characters and ideas this story generates (examples; magic, witches, mice). We will explore how we can portray the characters (how their bodies look, how their voices may sound, how they move). We will create a scene using the characters from the novel to perform at the mid-year showcase, using the student's ideas. The students will decide on the scene and we will develop a script and practice and perform this at the showcase.

Term 1 → Focus on Getting to Know the Story

- ❖ We will read a few chapters at the start of each lesson, and then spend the class exploring the ideas in this chapter.
 - For example, the chapter describing how to spot a witch would lead to a class focusing on how to embody the witch - their physical features.
- ❖ We will develop ideas on the story, and discuss elements we like embodying.
- ❖ This term should help the students to generate ideas on their performance piece at the end of the semester.

Term 2 → Develop, Practise and Perform a Piece Based off of the Story

- ❖ We will begin the Term with a recap of the story and then begin developing ideas of what we liked in the story and what we want to use in our play.
- ❖ From these I will devise a script using these ideas and we will spend our classes learning and practicing the performance.
- ❖ We will continue to explore how we can portray the characters' bodies, voices and movements to build their characters.
- ❖ At the end of this term, we will perform this script at the mid-year showcase.

Term 3 & 4 -

We will explore a new story, following similar steps as the ones listed above in order to prepare for the end-of-year performance, developing and building our characters and exploring the story, building up to our overall goal of the end-of-year performance. A more detailed plan will be provided closer to the time.
