We have caps at the museum for a donation of \$20 and also some small reusable grocery bags for a \$6 donation. They feature the museum logo.

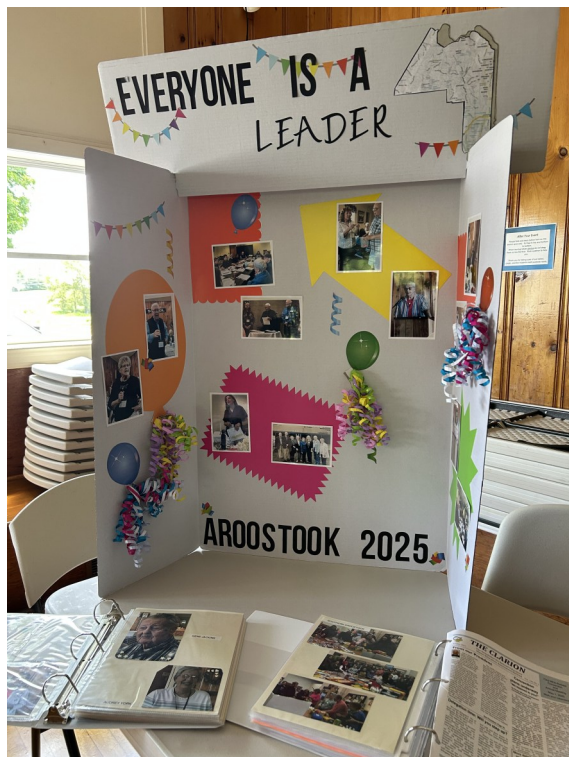

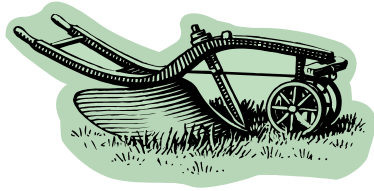
