Family Roots for Life, Inc. reunites, reconnects, and restores children, youth, and families through the provision of social, emotional, and behavioral health services to ensure child and family well-being.

THE NEED IN OUR STATE

- When a youth in foster care turns 18 in Texas, they may face challenges related to aging-out.
- Statistics indicate that 70% of females who have aged out of the foster care system become pregnant by the age of 21 and 60% of aged out males have been convicted of a crime.
- Further research shows that 20% of aged out youth become instantly homeless, approximately 80% experience mental health challenges, and 50% are likely to be unemployed by age 24.
- State and federal laws are in place to protect foster youth until they turn 21, thanks to the 2008
 Fostering Connections Act.


We envision a world in which every child and young adult has a secure, stable family enabling him or her to thrive and achieve his or her full potential.



- We connect the hearts and minds of like-missioned individuals and entities to achieve child and family well-being.


