

... Ever feel like you have a gun pointed to your head? How about Six? Eight? Well Folks, that's how Mainstage `97 was brought into this world.

...You see, faithful patron, Leslie Wilvers was having lunch with Michelle Troyer and me last May. Michelle and I were feverishly trying to find a good script for the upcoming year. Leslie screams "...you've got to do Crazy for You, I just saw it and it was hysterical." She neglected to tell us that this show is the biggest, most difficult tap dancing extravaganza to hit Broadway in forty years.

...Actually, this show has been in the making for nearly a century. Many of the songs go back to the early 1920's. Now here's the irony. Crazy For You opened on Broadway for its worldwide premiere on February 19, 1992--in spite of the fact that the composer for the show, George Gershwin, has been deceased since 1937! Here's what happened. The music of George and Ira Gershwin represents The Golden Age of Broadway. Wonderful songs like I've Got Rhythm were scattered throughout the small shows and B-Movies of the 30's. Under the brilliant comedic writing of playwright Ken Ludwig, Crazy

For You, resurrected the Gershwins' best hits in one of Broadway's biggest shows of the 90's.

...So anyway, New York sent us the script and promo stuff. Michelle read it and "...couldn't stop laughing." Lynda, music director extraordinaire, took a listen to the CD and, "...loves to do Big Band." Sheila, our Guild President, read the script and, "...fell in love all over again" gush, gush. The actors listened to the plot synopsis and "...couldn't get enough." Marg Vick, choreographer a.k.a. superwoman, and I looked over the entire show and "...took a massive coronary." HAS EVERYONE COMPLETELY LOST IT!!! We are bringing the biggest, most difficult tap dancing extravaganza to our humble little stage! "...Is everyone back East this stupid or are you just special?" (that's a stolen line from the show).

...So eager patron, you guessed it, we picked a doozy!! This school has been alive with tap dancing lessons six nights a week since September and somehow we've managed to squeeze in just as many acting and singing lessons but we did it! At times its been like "...one collective crawl over jagged glass fest," or as Davey put it, "...we started as peons-but then we got good."




McGOWAN, Dave (Sam, Cowboy Choir, Hoofer)


MORRISON, Jared (Lank Hawkins)





As president of the Guild I sincerely thank each and every member who has so generously contributed this year — we couldn't do it without you!


