





Dr. Elaine McDougall

Organizations, People, Ideas and Structures come and go, but the vision of a single person is their immortal gift to the next generation.

This year's recipient of the Silver Falcon Award for Outstanding Lifetime Achievement is Elaine McDougall. Dr. McDougall was a vice-principal of Foothills Composite High School and was the founder and original Director of The Alberta High School of Fine Arts.

People like Elaine, see things within a picture that few others can often understand. By the time everyone sees it, it is common practice and—although no longer visionary—it has made its impact; it has created the change. The person of vision moves onto something else and if we are lucky they will continue to create the common practice of the future: they will build for us a better tomorrow!!

This combination is the characteristic trademark of someone who lives a very successful and full life. Her strength, her compassion, her character and her person allow this titan of vision to change the world. And what a change she has made! As a founder of the Alberta High School of Fine Arts, she has made a place for young artists to hone their craft, a friendly place to come in from out of the cold. Mainstage, itself, would not exist today without her vision and courage to reach beyond. Her extensive understanding of how human beings learn has changed the lives of many students, from those who are university bound to those who never thought they could pass a remedial course. Her work has lead to a personal exploration of her own learning that turned into a PhD. this spring!! But the side of Elaine that everyone knows only too well is her absolute love and dedication for the students see serves. Once the Board of Directors chose a winning nomination for this award the next phase is a vote of approval by the cast. A roar of applause and shouts of praise followed this very unanimous vote!!

In September, Dr. McDougall will take on the role as Principal of ABC Charter School for the Gifted in Calgary...and what a Gift she will be.


Shandy McQueen (Rizzo)


Ryan Moore (Doody Understudy)


Bryan Webb (Danny)
