PHE/16/23 PREVIOUS MINUTES

The Minutes of the meeting held on **6 February 2023** were approved.

PHE/17/23 MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES: Cllr Black reminded the clerk of the requirement to obtain a list of the council's land title deeds held by Macdonald Oates (solicitors).

PHE/18/23 HIGHWAYS / WINTER RESILIANCE / BUS SHELTERS

Traffic Consultant & CCTV: Cllr Buchanan to progress. Action (Cllr Buchanan)

Speed Indication Devices: Despite assurances from West Sussex Highways the VAS outside the Fernhurst Club remains non-operational. **(Action: Clerk)** With the resignation of Nigel Barker there has been no progress on Speed Indicator Devices.

Fernden Lane Bus Shelter: Quotation from Mike Fordham to be pursued. Action: (Clerk)

Highways Maintenance: Patching repairs to Vann Road have been postponed multiple times because of some very wet weather.

Highways Signage: Signs to indicate the location of the Car Park, WC's and Doctors Surgery are still required. **Action: (Clerk)**

Copyhold Footpath: Councillors had inspected the footpath and considered the current draft proposals for a minor diversion to be acceptable.

Church Road: Drainage issues are to be investigated with the possible assistance of John Jordan. **Action:** (Clerk)

PHE/19/23 - VAN COMMON / VILLAGE GREEN

Van Common: Completion and return of Operation Watershed certificate required. Action: (Clerk)

Tree Inspection: Following the Tree Inspection Report the clerk had accepted the lowest quotation from Adam Gibson.

PHE/20/23 - PUBLIC TOILETS: The following requirements remain outstanding:

PHE/22/23 PUBLIC SEATS

Routine maintenance only required, which is weather dependent.

PHE/23/24 CEMETERY

Memorials that have been removed for safety reasons are to be identified and reinstalled, if suitable. The quotation received to date is regarded as expensive. Further options to be explored.

The current maintenance contractor has agreed to remove the ivy on the eastern boundary at a hourly rate.

The Cemetery Regulations are to be reviewed.

A Commonwealth War Graves plaque has been installed.

PHE/24/23 ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES

Possible opportunities to install publicly accessible electric vehicle charging points in the Crossfield car park are being pursued. Unfortunately, owing to the low density of local population these are likely to be a low priority at County and District level.
