

Suggestions for Studying

- **Practice, practice, practice.** I did 60-80 problems from previous exams preparing.
- **Plenty of practice problems from previous exams.** Rodriguez has solutions from previous students on website and solutions can often be found online.
- First, do as many problems as you can. If you identify areas you need to brush up on, only then hit the books (see Reference Texts.pdf)
- Focus on topics likely to come (see Equations sheet)
- Form a study group and work together

Further Suggestions

- Do **live practice questions**, time yourself. Aim for ~ 40 minutes average per problem (obviously, some might be longer, some shorter).
- About 2-4 weeks before, do a practice mock exam.
- Look over entire exam, tackle problems you know how to solve first
