

FACEBOOK AND INSTAGRAM PRIVACY POLICY

This Privacy Policy applies to all personal information collected by Tia Stephenson (ABN: 77506387476) and Cait Mahony (ABN: 19469734371) via the Facebook page located https://www.facebook.com/profile.php?id=100088494050563 and Instagram page located at https://www.instagram.com/pvot_hub/?igshid=YmMyMTA2M2Y%3D.

1. What is "personal information"?

- (a) The Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) currently defines "personal information" as meaning information or an opinion about an identified individual or an individual who is reasonably identifiable:
 - (i) whether the information or opinion is true or not; and
 - (ii) whether the information or opinion is recorded in a material form or not.
- (b) If the information does not disclose your identity or enable your identity to be ascertained, it will in most cases not be classified as "personal information" and will not be subject to this privacy policy.

2. What information do we collect?

The kind of personal information that we collect from you will depend on how you use the Facebook or Instagram page. The personal information which we collect and hold about you may include: your name, email address, phone number, or address. Facebook and Instagram may also use third parties to analyse traffic on the page, which may involve the use of cookies. On Facebook and Instagram there may also be links to third party websites and we are not responsible for the content or privacy practices employed by websites that are linked from the Facebook or Instagram page.

3. How we collect your personal information

- (a) We may collect personal information from you whenever you input such information into Facebook, Instagram, or Facebook Messenger.
- (b) We may also collect cookies from your computer which enable us to tell when you use the page and also to help customise your experience. As a general rule, however, it is not possible to identify you personally from our use of cookies.

4. Purpose of collection

- (a) The purpose for which we collect personal information is to provide you with the best service experience possible on the Facebook and Instagram page.
- (b) We customarily disclose personal information only to our service providers who assist us in operating the Facebook and Instagram page. Your personal information may



also be exposed from time to time to maintenance and support personnel acting in the normal course of their duties.

(c) By using our Facebook or Instagram page, you consent to the receipt of direct marketing material. We will only use your personal information for this purpose if we have collected such information direct from you, and if it is material of a type which you would reasonably expect to receive from us. We do not use sensitive personal information in direct marketing activity. Our direct marketing material will include a simple means by which you can request not to receive further communications of this nature.

5. Access and correction

Australian Privacy Principle 12 permits you to obtain access to the personal information we hold about you in certain circumstances, and Australian Privacy Principle 13 allows you to correct inaccurate personal information subject to certain exceptions. If you would like to obtain such access, please contact us as set out below.

6. Complaint procedure

If you have a complaint concerning the manner in which we maintain the privacy of your personal information, please contact us as set out below. All complaints will be considered by Tia Stephenson and Cait Mahony and we may seek further information from you to clarify your concerns. If we agree that your complaint is well founded, we will, in consultation with you, take appropriate steps to rectify the problem. If you remain dissatisfied with the outcome, you may refer the matter to the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner.

7. Overseas transfer

Your personal information will not be disclosed to recipients outside Australia unless you expressly request us to do so. If you request us to transfer your personal information to an overseas recipient, the overseas recipient will not be required to comply with the Australian Privacy Principles and we will not be liable for any mishandling of your information in such circumstances.
