

LOVERS KEY STATE PARK

Lovers Key is a 712-acre tropical bliss widely recognized by lovers as a personal hideaway with its remote and solitary beach. It consists of 4 barrier islands: Lovers Key, Inner Key, Long Key and Black Island, and is located at 8700 Estero Blvd., Fort Myers Beach.

Lovers Key is blessed with gorgeous and uncontaminated white sand. Favorite activities at Lovers Key State Park include hiking, bicycling, boating, kayaking, canoeing, paddle boarding, sunbathing, swimming, picnicking, boating, shelling and it is a haven for wildlife. Lovers Key provides opportunities to view the wonderfully diverse wildlife which include marsh rabbits, dolphins, manatees and over 40 bird species (including bald eagles, woodpeckers, owls, hawks, etc.) Lovers Key State Park is open from 8:00 am till sundown year round.

BOWDITCH POINT PARK

Bowditch Point Park is 17-acres of gorgeous white sand beach and inland park located at the northern tip of Estero Island, with panoramic views of Estero Bay. This beautiful beach was widened recently and now wraps around the end of the island. Activities you can engage in include picnicking, bird watching, strolling along the beach, swimming and sunbathing.



You'll find restroom facilities, picnic tables and snack stands at the park. Kayaks and other activities are available for rent from the tour operator, Calusa Ghost Tours. There is also disabled access and an accessible boat dock. Unless there is an event happening, there is plenty of parking.

TIMES SQUARE

Times Square is located at the intersection of San Carlos Boulevard Estero Boulevard, and is surrounded by gorgeous, white sandy beaches, palm and the Gulf of Mexico. Times Square is saturated with its nightlife, shopping and entertainment, considered the heartbeat of Estero Island's downtown.

Times Square is recognized as the busiest area for tourists, and features outdoor dining and talented street performers. There are also plenty of spots to sit down and relax.

LYNN HALL MEMORIAL PARK

Lynn Hall Memorial Park is a small, popular beachside park with a fishing pier, restrooms, showers & parking, plus picnic & grill facilities. If you love swimming, sunbathing, volley ball or fishing, you'll love to hang out here. It is the ideal location if you'll be going shopping, getting some food or have children.

The park provides a range of amenities for its guests, including bathrooms, children playgrounds, picnic shelters, outside showers and a nature kiosk that contain information about animals and plants. In addition, the pier offers a fantastic spot for fishing which is a licensed fishing pier. There are wheel chair accessible washrooms, and the beach is also wheel chair accessible.

CRESCENT BEACH FAMILY PARK

Crescent Beach Family Park is a little south of the pier on Fort Myers Beach. It is a family-friendly beachfront park that is a minute walk from Times Square and the parking lot at Lynn Hall Park.

There is lots of open space, air conditioned restrooms, two handicap parking spaces, a gorgeous landscaped picnic area which houses three picnic shelters, and a large sandy part of the park reserved for beach volleyball. Note however that there is no alcohol allowed.

FORT MYERS BEACH PUBLIC LIBRARY

Fort Myers Beach Library is located on the Gulf of Mexico in beautiful Estero Boulevard. This topnotch, spectacular library has lots of intriguing <u>pictures</u> and posters to look at, with everything you could ever want from a library.

You can get a guest card that will last you for a month for \$10, and you can donate books to or get books from this wonderful library. The third-floor cafe has some of the most delicious sandwiches of any eatery in town, and the prices are incredibly low

DOG BEACH

Even though there are dog parks in the area, if your dog loves the water, it will have more fun at the beach. It's not illegal to take your dog to Fort Myers Beach, and dogs are allowed off the leash at this area of the beach. It is significant to note that cleanup stations are provided. Be sure to pick up after your dog.

Note however, that you will need to have a copy of health records with you at all times. The beach is run by Lees County Parks and Recreation. Note however, that dogs are not allowed in state parks, which means no dogs inside Lovers Key State Park. Don't confuse this with Lovers Key Dog Park where dogs are welcome, as mentioned above.

ADVENTURE GOLF

Smugglers Cove Adventure Golf course at Fort Myers Beach is an 18-hole Adventure style miniature golf course situated on the fantastic Barry Island promenade and features a live educational alligator exhibit.

It is a big favorite of the kids, but there are different levels of difficulty to keep everyone interested. You can visit at any time because it is open to the public every day 9 a.m - 11 p.m., and is open every day, even on Christmas Day.

You can check out 18-holes of mini golf in the midst of a tropical scene set between 25 real American Alligators, lakes, waterfalls, pirates, rock gardens and caves. One big favorite activity for everyone is feeding the alligators with an old style bamboo cane fishing pole. The course is very clean and well maintained with beautiful grounds.

PARASAILING - THERE ARE MANY BEACH VENDORS THAT OFFER PARASAILING. CHECK GOOGLE

Parasailing, otherwise known as parascending or parakiting, is a popular recreational watersport activity where an individual is hauled behind a speeding boat, car or truck all the time being connected to a specially designed canopy wing by a tow rope. The canopy is reminiscent of a parachute, and is known as a parasail wing.

The manned kite's moving anchor may be a vehicle, truck, or boat, but in Fort Myers Beach, it is almost always a motor boat. Two or three people can parasail at the same time if the boat is powerful enough. Parasailing in Fort Myers Beach allows you to capture the beautiful scenes of Fort Myers Beach and Sanibel Island from 1200. When looking for thrilling vacation things to do, Parasailing is a watersports activity you don't want to miss!

MOUND HOUSE 451 Connecticut St (239) 765-0865

Mount House is a very nice, fully operational museum with archeological artifacts situated on beautiful, peaceful grounds with bay views. Historically and archeologically significant, Mount House has been developed to gain more insight into the history of the area.

This museum and grounds are well worth a few hours of your family's vacation. At \$10 a pop, membership is reasonably priced and worth every dollar to support this fascinating archaeological exhibit owned by the city of Fort Myers Beach.



MATANZAS PASS PRESERVE 199 Bay Rd FMB



Matanzas Pass Preserve is a 60-acre area of protected land located on the seven-mile long barrier island of Estero in Lee County, Florida. The 60 acre preserve runs along Matanzas Pass and is one of the few undeveloped, protected areas on the island. Essentially, it offers visitors the rarest of opportunities to experience Estero Island as it was before it became the popular beach resort that it is today.

There is also a diversity of wildlife including raccoons, rabbits, hawks, owls, turtles, snakes, herons, fish, and songbirds. You can see all of this while traversing the 1.25 miles of boardwalks and trails within the 60 acre preserve.

The Matanazas Pass Preserve also provides a diverse variety of educational opportunities including guided walks, volunteer training, tours led by an ethnobotanist, stress detox tours and the new children's educational program featuring Earth Ed.

OSTEGO BAY MARINE SCIENCE CENTER 718 FISHERMANS WHARF ON SAN CARLOS ISLAND

Ostego Bay Marine Science Center is a little, out of the way, sea museum located at 718 Fishermans Wharf on San Carlos Island in Fort Myers Beach and completely focused around the local aquatic life. The center has been providing a Marine Science Experience through interactive exhibits, aquariums, touch tank, one of kind collections and unique displays. Drop in for an hour to get educated on the local aquatic life.

The friendly and personable staff are eager to share stories and information. There is a large shell collection and a few tanks with native fish. The center is a great spot to stop on your way out to the beach, especially if you have inquisitive kids who love nature. The staff try to make use of all the space they have are always looking for <u>feedback</u> to improve the space and make it even more welcoming for visitors

Fort Myers Beach is one of the top destinations for water sports and other exciting activities, and if one aqua activity that's tearing up the surf in Fort Myers Beach is Flyboarding. If you love watersports, you will find flyboarding a big thrill. A Flyboard allows the rider to use water pressure to effectively 'fly' over the water.

The rider adorns a helmet as well as a life jacket to be safe and stands erect and connected by straps to a board. There is a jet-ski engine that effectively supplies the power to pump the water into the board, and this is what tends to propel it upwards. The instructor will be on the jet-ski controlling the pressure.

KAYAKING/STAND UP PADDLE BOARDING

Kayaking is one of the most popular watersports that involves paddling using a double-bladed oar and a small boat known as a kayak in a wide variety of waterways. The boat sits low in the water and usually only accommodates a single paddler, but there are kayaks that hold or three people.

Kayaks are specialized boats which take a number of forms, which depends on the specific function for which they have been designed. You can take a kayaking trip on rivers, along white water courses, the ocean, and in surf zones. The great thing about kayaking is that you can really enjoy yourself even if you have minimal skills. If you are interested in kayaking and this is your first time, you can easily rent a kayak or take part in guided kayaking trips at a destination.

Standup paddle boarding is a combination of kayaking and surfing, and is currently the fastest-growing water sport globally with gear sales up by about 200% in the past year according to retailers. Even though paddle boarding provides a total-body workout, it is a sport that can be tried by people of all ages and fitness levels.

You don't need waves to paddleboard unlike surfing, and if you're a beginner, you need very calm, flat water. The beauty of paddle boarding is that, unlike surfing, you can do it on an ocean, lake, and even a river," says White.

A seashell also known simply as a shell, is a hard, protective outer layer created by an animal that lives in the sea. Note that the shell is actually part of the body of the animal.

If you are shelling, you may come across an empty shell. What you should realize about empty shells is that they are empty because the animal has died and the soft parts have been eaten by another animal or may have rotted out. If you're new to shelling, it is the easiest thing for you to learn. All it takes is to walk across the beach where there are shells, find a shell and pick the ones that you are interested in.

There are small matted original works and mini masters all on sale for as little as \$10. If you're lucky, you could find artists actually painting, or you might see a workshop in progress. Some artists also give short art classes, teaching oil, watercolor, acrylic, and other mediums.

JET SKIING

Jet skiing is an exhilarating watersport A Jet Ski is part water skiing device and part speedboat that uses an enclosed gas-powered motor to literally push water out in a jet stream. Someone sits at the back of you for your safety but you get to do all the driving. A jet ski is very much like a motorcycle, and acceleration is provided by a hand-powered throttle located on the right-side grip.

Simply by twisting the throttle, the driver can increase power to machine's motor. To steer the machine, you need to point the front-mounted grips and maneuver the body. However, unlike an actual motorbike, this machine often requires a high degree of acceleration to complete sharp turns in the water.

You can also find some great fishing from the Lighthouse Pier on the eastern tip of Sanibel.

Fishing charters are a great way to not only have a great day on the water, but potentially hold the key to a fantastic dinner when you return. The Gulf and Estero Bay waters surrounding Fort Myers Beach hold a bounty of Redfish, Trout, Snapper, Sheepshead, Grouper, and Shark, among other species, many of which are fantastic eating. Typically your charter captain will clean and fillet your catch, and can recommend a **restaurant** that will cook your fish for you.

Charter options range from Offshore aka "Deep Sea Fishing" and Inshore "Flats Fishing" for half day, full day and night charters. "Head Boats" which are larger vessels that carry anywhere from 20 and up anglers are a budget option. Be sure to read additional Fort Myers Beach Fishing information including licenses if you plan to fish on your own.

Prices are \$45 for night shark fishing, \$60 for the 1/2 day fishing trip, and \$400 for the overnight weekend Dry Tortugas trip.

One great part about a visit to Fort Myers Beach is that you can easily add on a trip to Key West for a very reasonable price, most of the time cheaper than even driving. If you've come a long way to Florida, a trip to Key West would be a shame to leave for another time. Key West is bustling with restaurants, bars, shopping, quaint hotelsand generally just very active. The ferry dock is only a few blocks from famous Duvall St, making it easy to get from the ferry to everything else. You can even take your bike on the ferry if you desire, although at \$34 round trip it only makes sense if you plan to stay a few days and really need it for getting around.

Day Trip vs Overnight:

I highly recommend an overnight stay in Key West, as there is so much to do and a day trip will only give you 4-5 hours to explore – hardly enough for Key West as you don't even get to experience

one night in town. There is no additional charge for either parking or the ticket price to return on another day, although their website doesn't really advertise that you can return on another day.

Important Security Information:

When leaving Fort Myers Beach, the Key West Express leaves from a private dock, and is not required to screen passengers in the same manner as when they leave from Key West, a government operated port facility. As such, you and your luggage for the return portion of your trip will be inspected in a similar manner as at the airport. With this in mind, make sure you don't bring firearms, knives and other similar items which may be subject to confiscation.

Ferry Schedule:

The Key West Express ferry boat to Key West leaves Fort Myers Beach on a daily basis during peak season, and Wednesdays through Sundays during the summer months.

- Departure from Fort Myers Beach is 8:30 am, ticketing begins at 7 am.
- Departure from Key West is 5 pm, ticketing begins at 5 pm.
- Travel time from Fort Myers Beach to Key West is about 3 1/2 hours once underway
