Esther C. Peyton Scholarship Award

The Esther C. Peyton Memorial Scholarship Award was created to honor the memory of Soror Esther C. Peyton whose love for "undergraduates" was contagious and who worked tirelessly to help provide financial support for them.

Soror Peyton graduated from Howard University with a BS Degree and later took courses from Columbia University. She was a retired Elementary Teacher after a forty- year career in the Public Schools of Washington, DC, an avid Sunday School Teacher of the Metropolitan Baptist Church and a supporter of the many Youth and Children Activities of her Church.

Her accomplishments in Zeta are noteworthy because they represent many "firsts" and some of which have remained a constant of our great Sorority. Among them: the first "Miss Zeta", organized the first Amicette Club, compiled and wrote the Archonian Key and the eight-lesson course for pledgees, the birth of the I.Z. (Interested in Zeta) Clubs. It was upon her insistence that Zeta Phi Beta become the first Sorority to establish a chapter in the nation of Liberia (in the City of Monrovia) which was followed by a Chapter at the University of Liberia. She presented the idea of organizing Life Members to Grand Basileus Wolfe who appointed her the first Chairman of Life Members.

She held the national office of Chairman of the Executive Board, the Mid-Atlantic Regional Director (composed of chapters from Virginia to Boston) and Chairman of Regional Directors.

When she was Regional Director, the Region honored her by circulating the "Little Esther" Cup to the chapter which had the best report. Then the "Esther Peyton Inspirational Cup" was created and was presented at each Boule to the Undergraduate Chapter that needed inspiration to bring it up to higher scholastic standards.

Soror Peyton always advocated for Undergraduates. It was her enthusiasm and continued desire to support Undergraduates that inspired the request for approval to establish the *Esther C. Peyton Memorial Scholarship Award* for Undergraduate Sorors of the Eastern Region. This was accomplished during the Administration of the 13th Eastern Regional Director, Soror Marilyn A. Brooks.

This award is to be presented to the Soror matriculating as a full-time student at an accredited College/University in the Eastern Region with the highest GPA. This is validated with the presentation of an official transcript from the institution.
