### **Addendum to Home Education Notification Form**

*(6) Brief outline of the intended curriculum for the current year. Such outline is for informational purposes only.*

History & Geography: Reading, maps, and related activities on Ancient historical figures and places.

Literature: Reading from various children's classics.

Science: Daily readings, hands-on experiments, and accompanying work in Botany.

Language arts: Phonics, spelling, reading, grammar, and writing exercises, various levels as appropriate per child.

Math: Instruction in various levels appropriate per child, using text, workbooks, and manipulative blocks.

Art education correlating to the curriculum topics.

Health and wellness along with kitchen and personal safety.

Foreign language lessons.

Any other previously assured subjects not specified above, except any concept, topic, or practice that is in conflict with my sincerely held religious beliefs, will be covered utilizing topically appropriate field trips (including museums, parks, and Ohio history centers), Internet, and library resources, and other real life learning opportunities.
